

# COMMONLY PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS FOR CHRONIC MEDICAL CONDITIONS

1. Your doctor may prescribe one or more of the following medications for your **Diabetes**:

<b>Biguanide</b>	Metformin
<b>Insulin</b>	insulin glargine (lantus, basaglar, toujeo), insulin degludec (Tresiba), NPH 70/30, insulin regular (Novolin R, humulin R), insulin aspart (novolog, fiasp), insulin lispro (Humalog, lispro, admelog)
<b>GIP/GLP-1 Agonist</b>	Tirzepatide (Mounjaro)
<b>GLP-1 Agonist</b>	Semaglutide (Ozempic), Liraglutide (Victoza), Dulaglutide (Trulicity), Exenatide (Bydureon)
<b>SGLT2 inhibitor</b>	Empagliflozin (Jardiance), Dapagliflozin (Farxiga), Canagliflozin (Invokana)
<b>Sulfonylureas</b>	Glipizide, Glyburide
<b>Thiazolidinediones</b>	Pioglitazone (Actos)
<b>DPP-4</b>	Sitagliptin (Januvia), Linagliptin (Tradjenta), Saxagliptin (Onglyza), Alogliptin (Nesina)
